This term in class we are learning about...

- How to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops in a sentence.

- In history we will be learning about the Great Fire of London as well as testing how the fire spread. In Geography we will be looking at different map skills.
- We will also be looking at light and shadows during our Design Technology lessons







Book Bags and reading records - Book bags are used to transport children's homework, letters and other items that your child needs to take backwards and forwards from home to school. Just a reminder to parents and children that book bags and reading records should be brought into school every day so that children can read their books with an adult in school. We read their books every day and if it is not in school they cannot get their books changed as often as they'd like.
