


Believe, Achieve, Soar with Pride

Welcome to the summer term in year 6 - amazingly it's already the children's finally term in primary school! The first half term, we will be focusing on preparation for the SATs which take place w/b 13th May and then after SATs we will spend more time exploring our other topics and hopefully have more time for fun!



This half term our lessons will include:

- Revision of grammar, punctuation and spelling objectives before SATs and then a study of the book 'Street Child' in English.
- Reviewing all of the key year 6 maths objectives and focusing on problem solving tasks to prepare for our maths SATs.
- Studying changes during the Victorian era in history and the Victorians will also be the stimulus for some of our other work including: Victorian music; the work of William Morris in art and design; and designing moving toys in design technology.
- Finding out about the formation of hills and mountains in geography.
- Learning about living things and their habitats as well as evolution and adaptation in science.
- Revising what we know about Christianity in RE.
- Creating algorithms and studying 'What is Code?' in our computing lessons.




<u>Homework</u>
