Mondrian and Kandinsky.

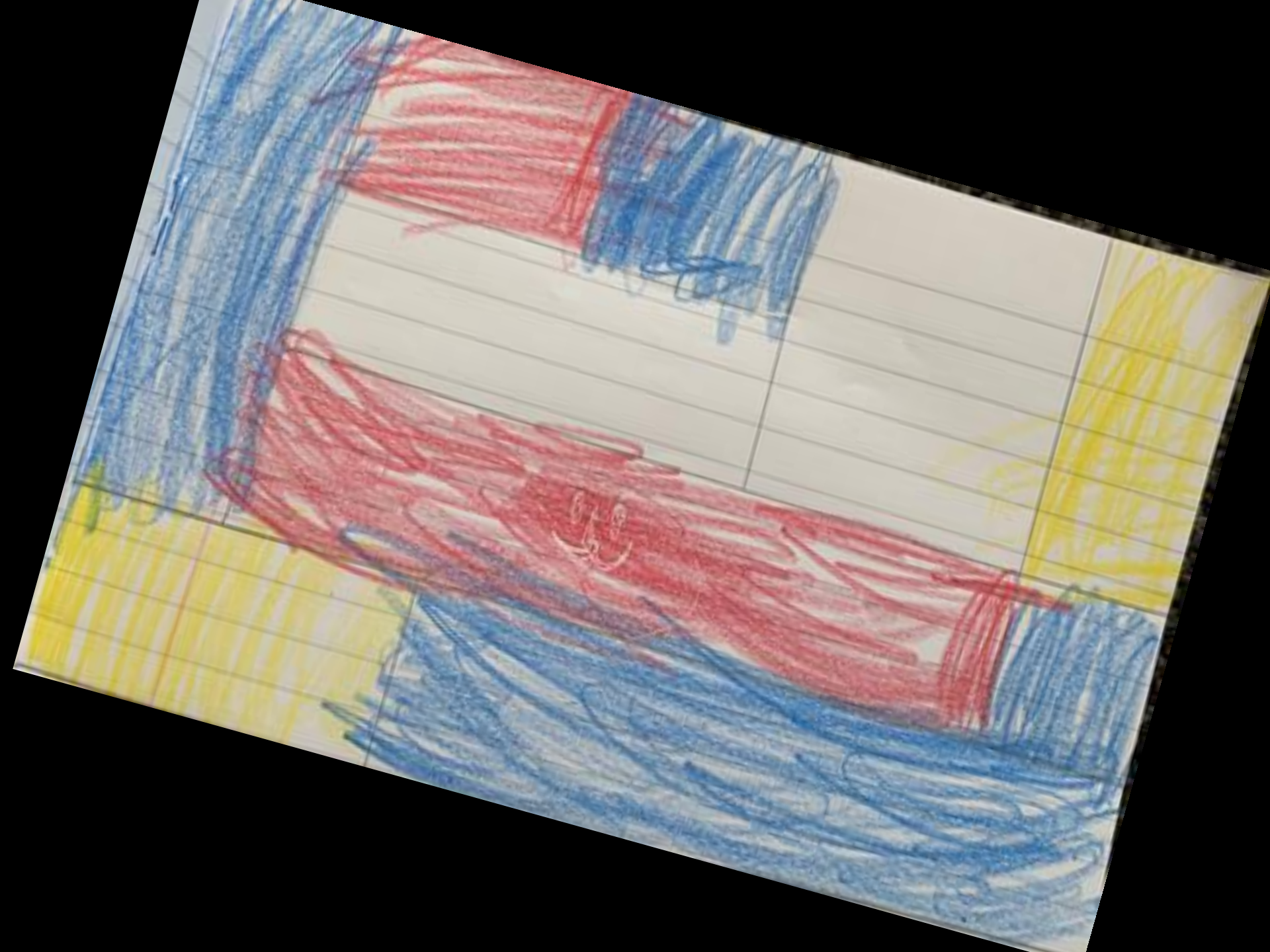


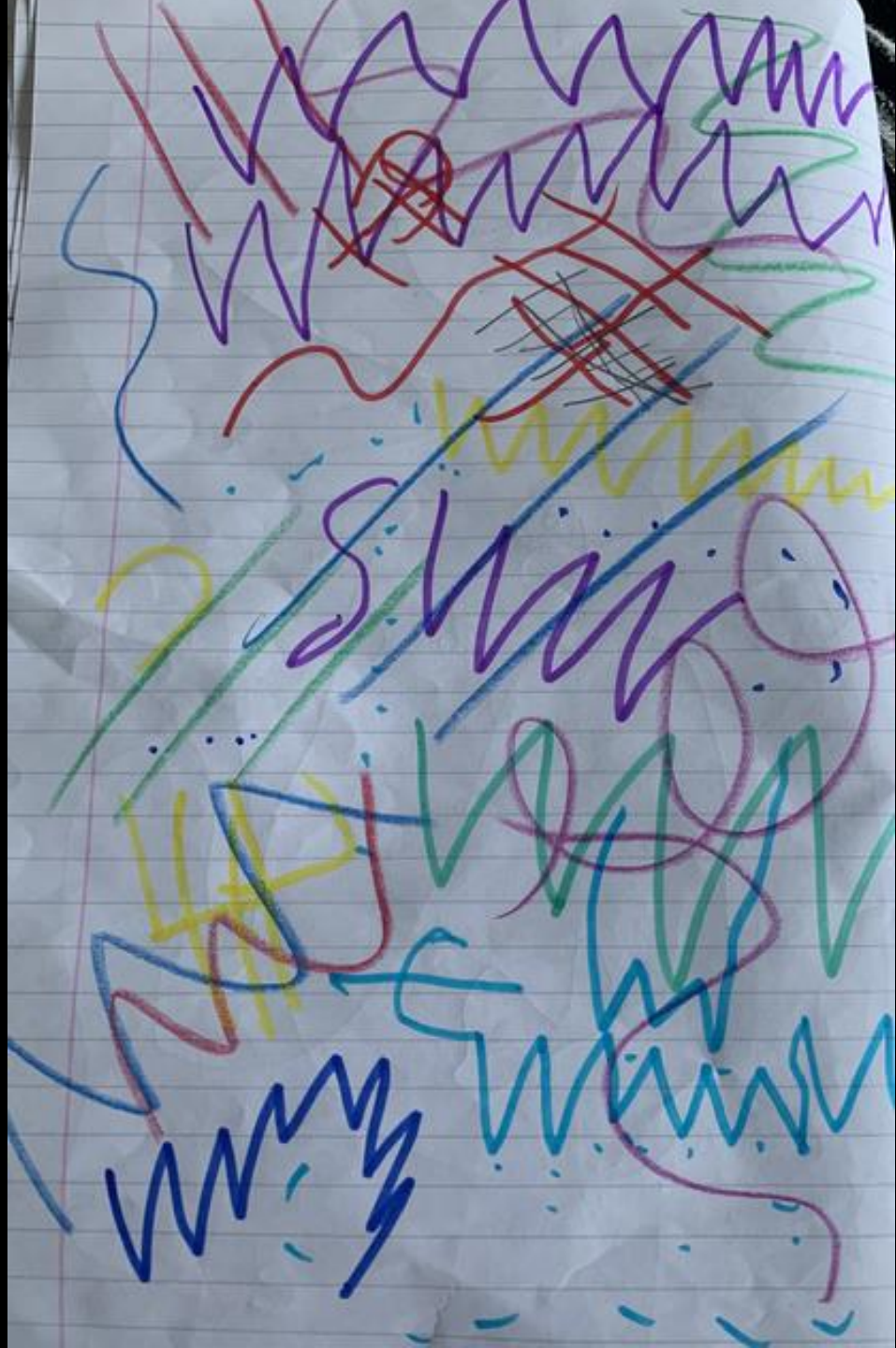

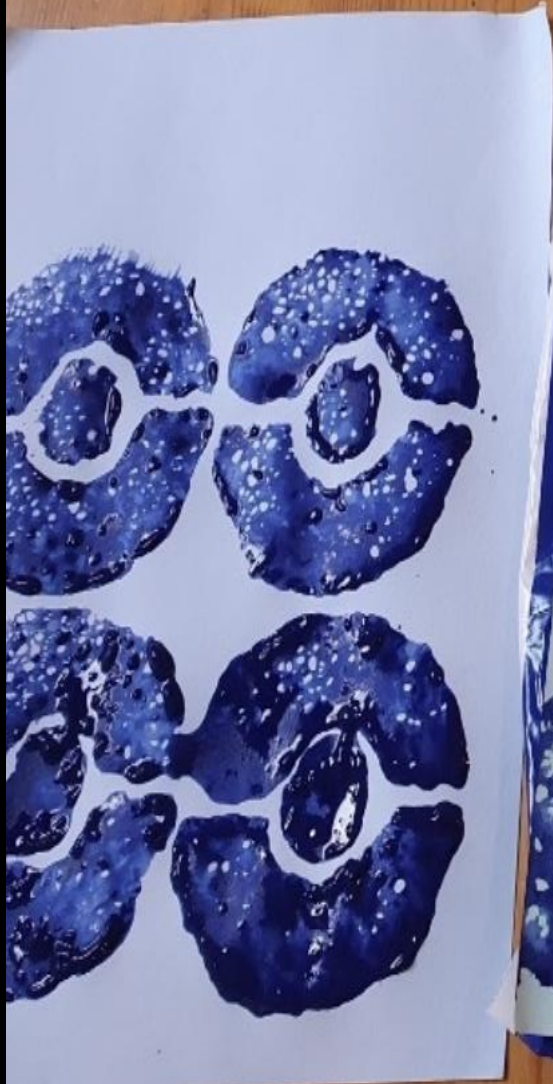
Year 3

Mosaics

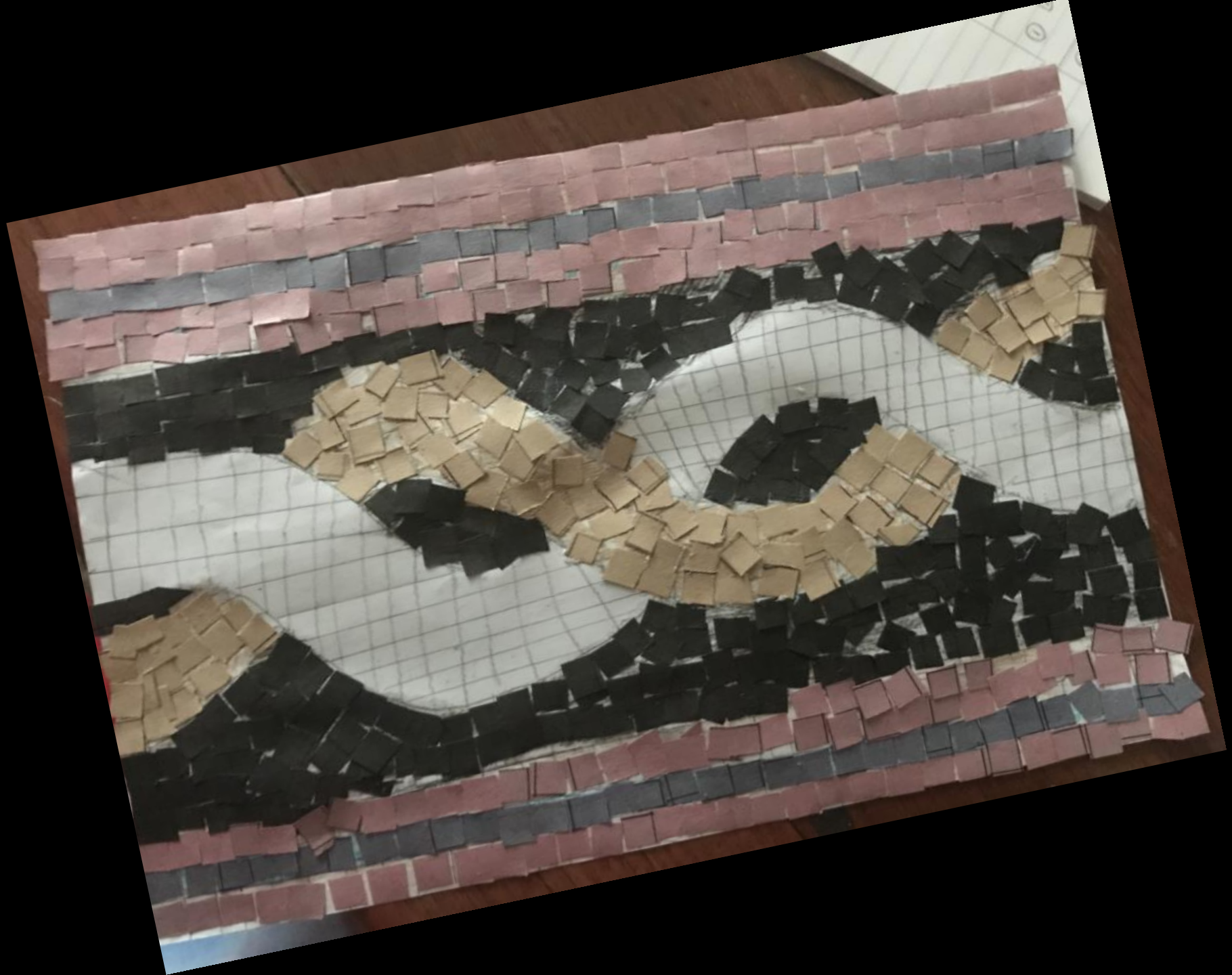
Year 4

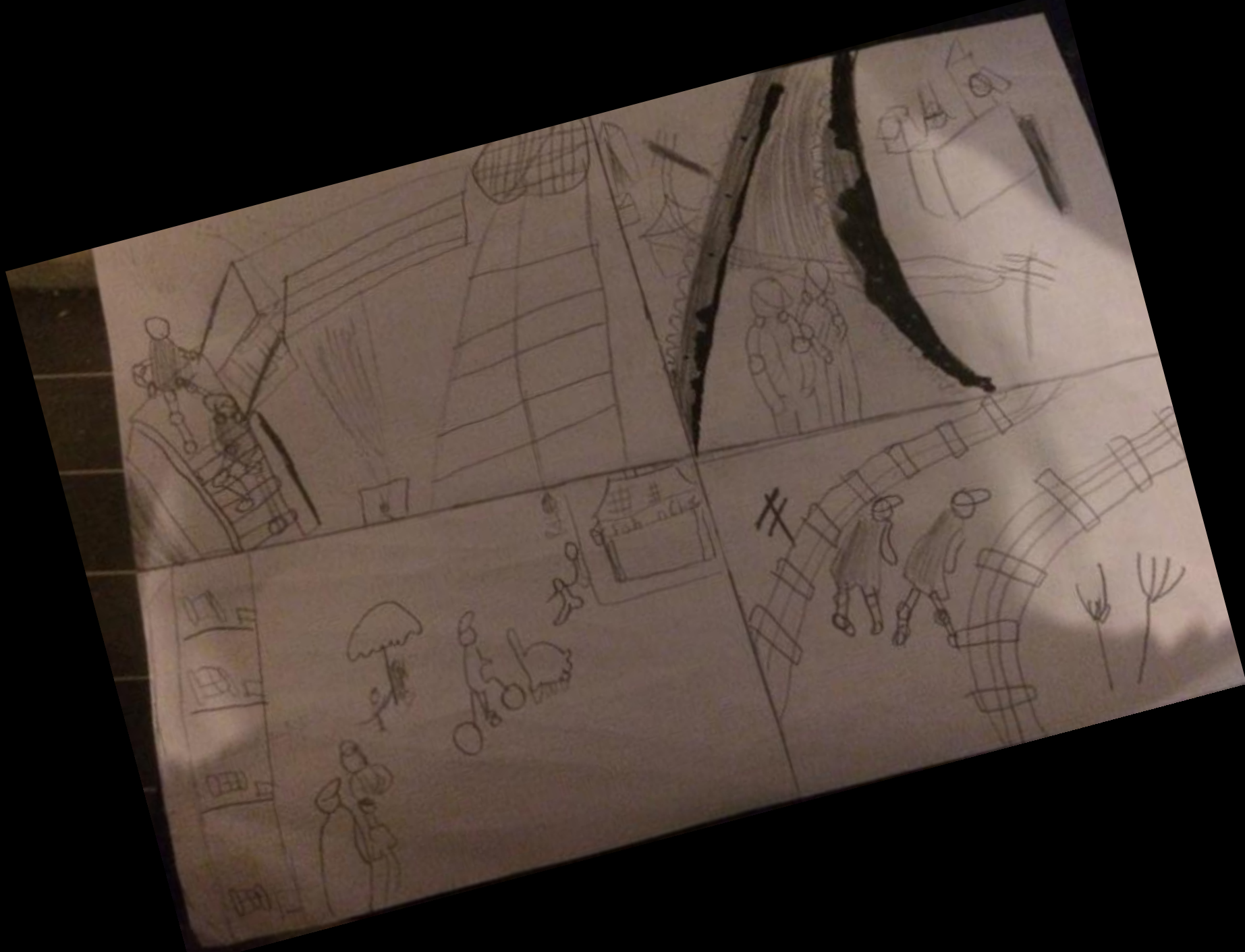


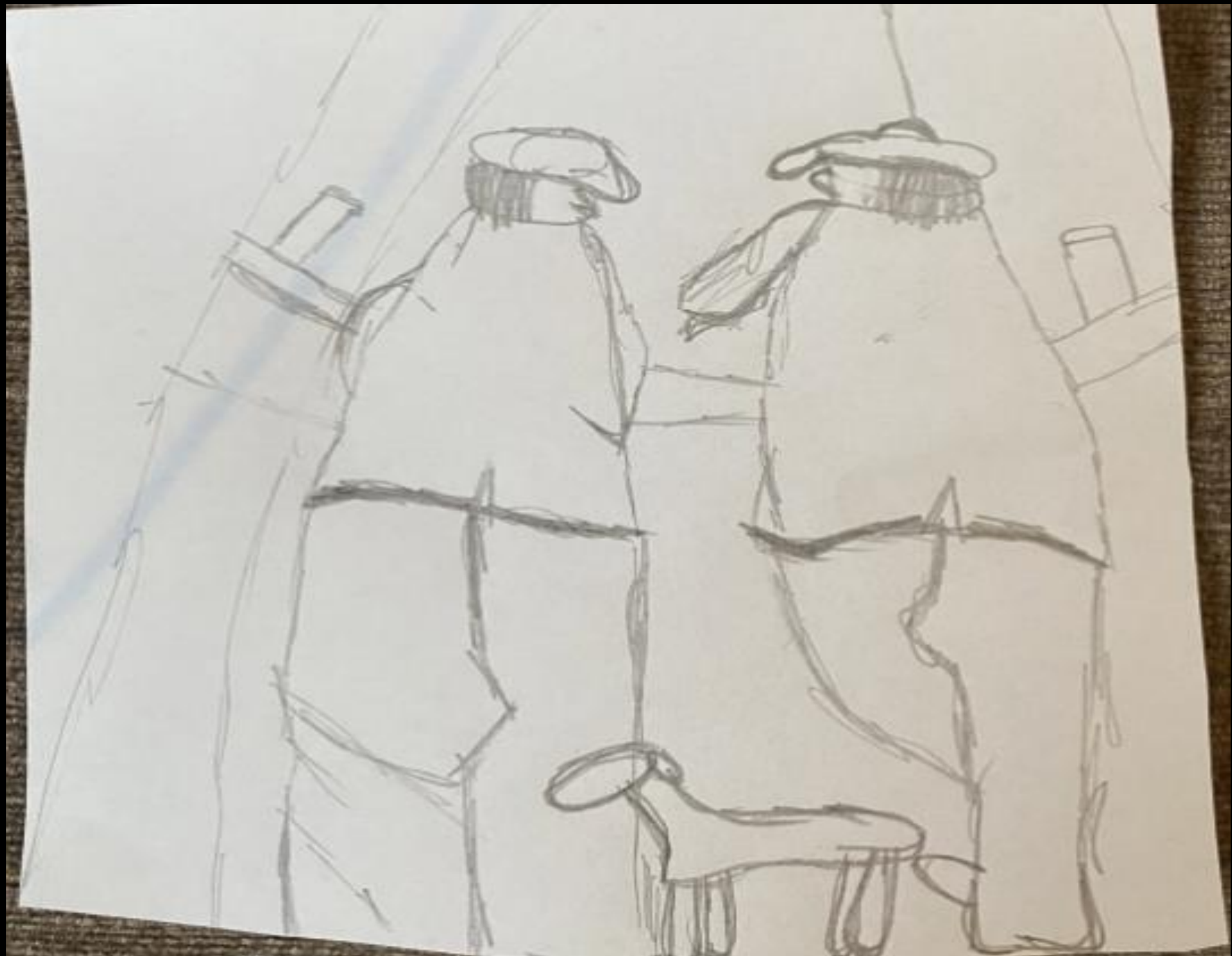
Year 5

What do you think about the colours used in this drawing?

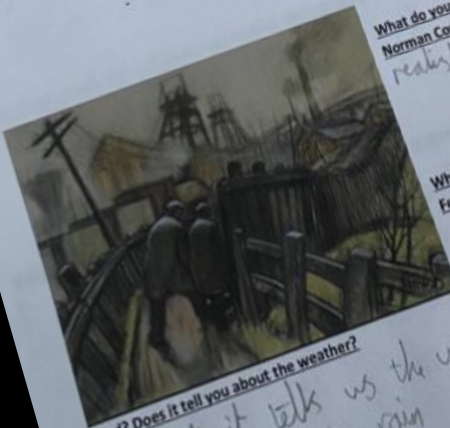
I think the colours make it realistic and older.

Why do you think Norman Cornish decided to draw a picture of this?

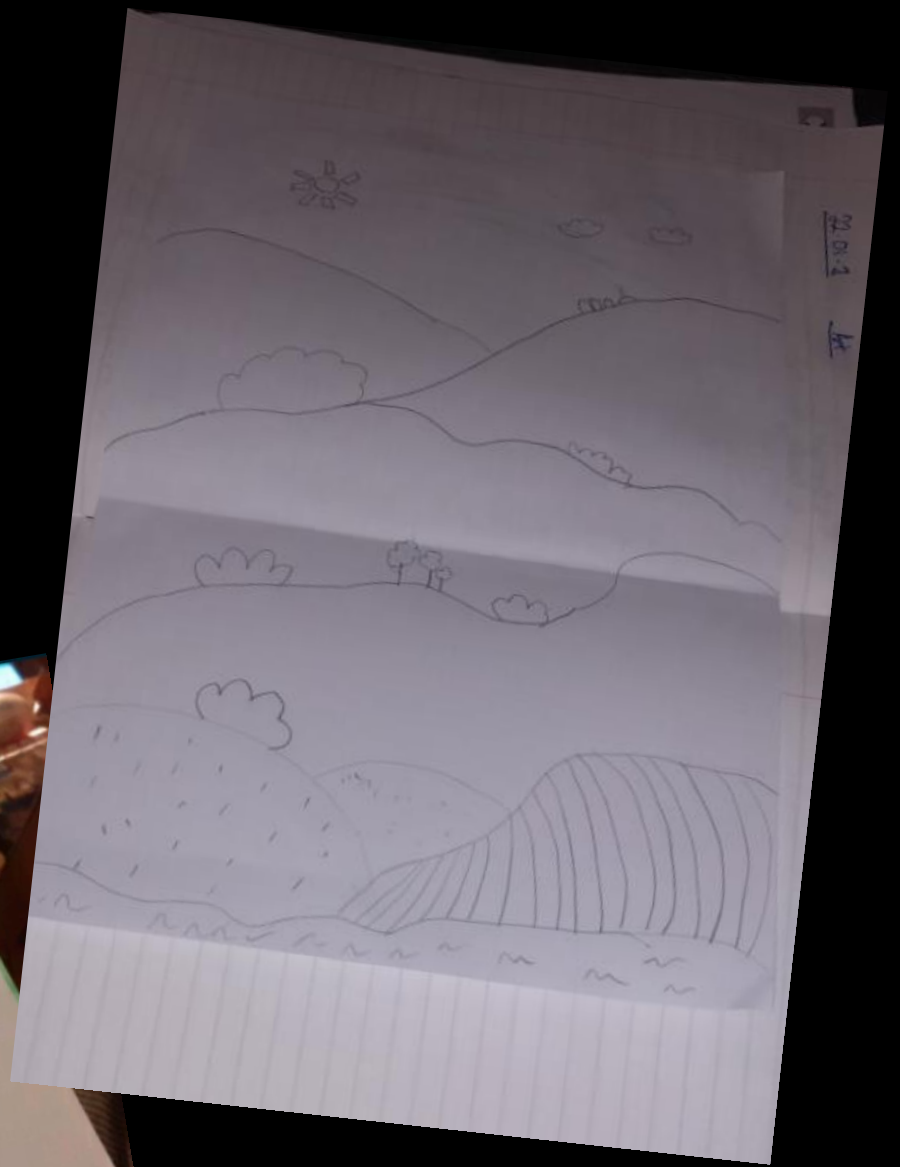
Because he wanted to challenge himself and get creativity

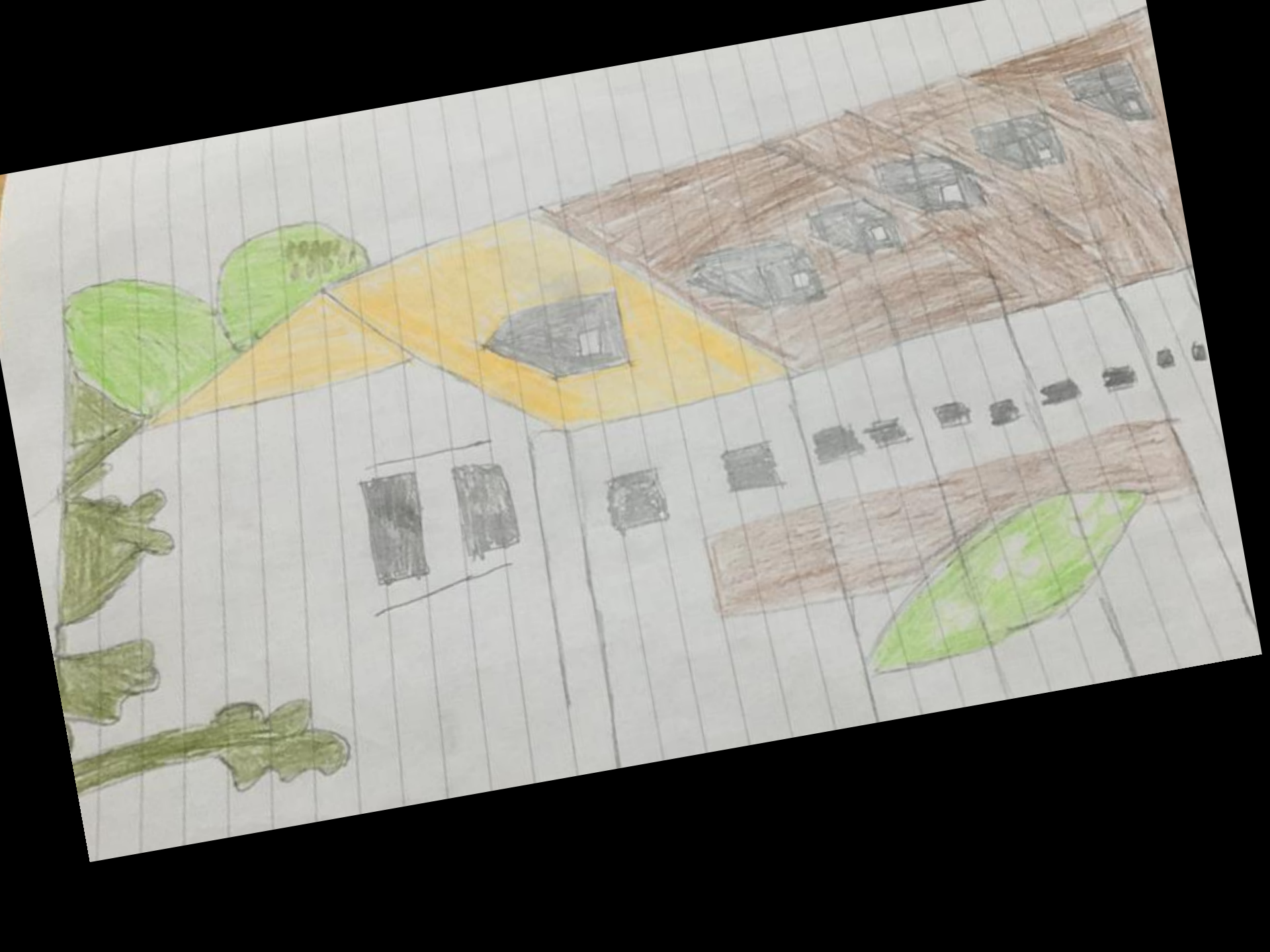

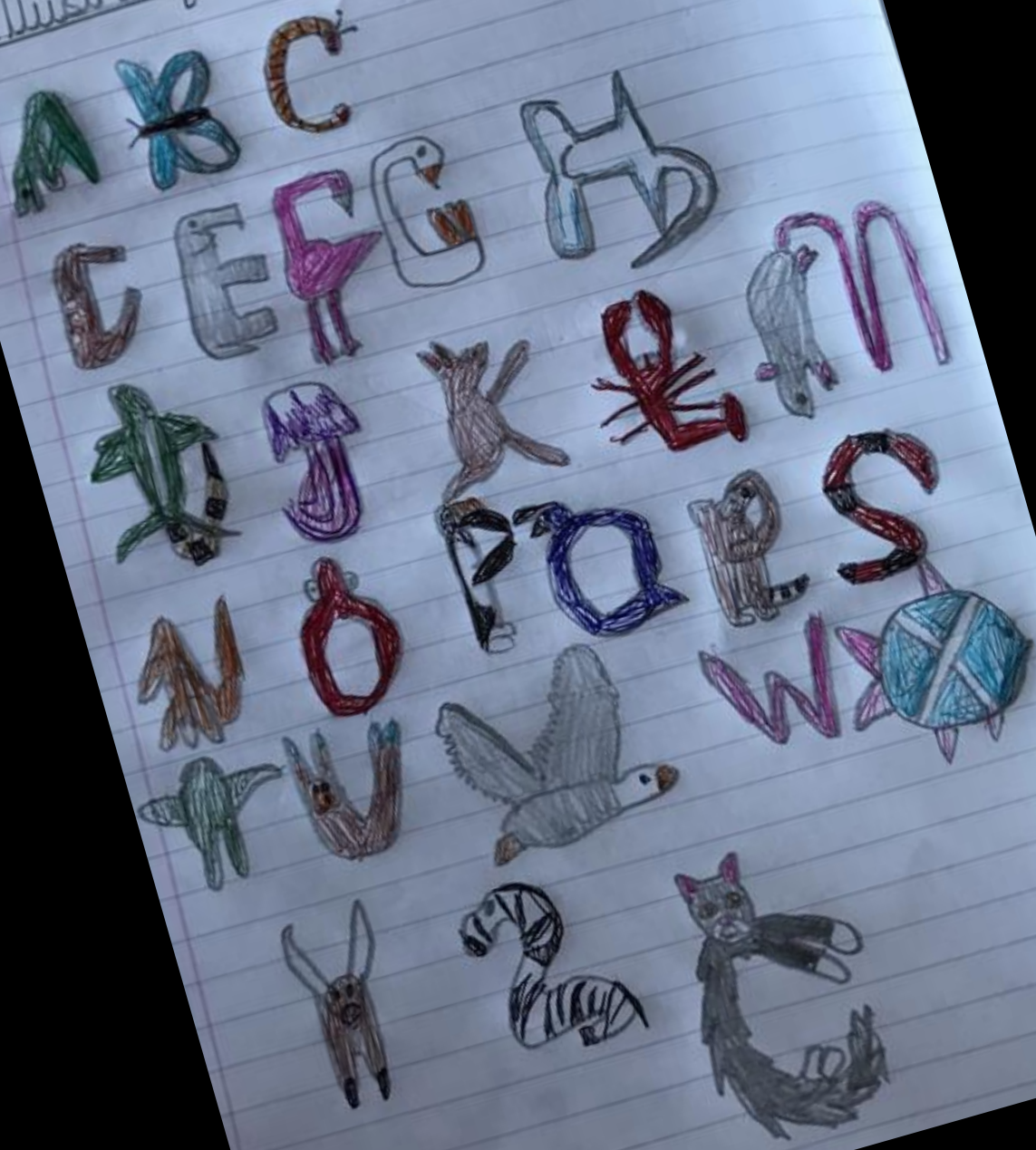
