Attendance

ALL absences must be reported to the school office on the first day of absence to notify us of the reasons for absences and the expected date of return, otherwise they may be recorded as unauthorised which could possibly lead to referrals to the Attendance Improvement Team.

Day 1

Child absent from school, no reason for absence provided School office to call parents/carers
If school is unable to contact parents/carers a class DOJO message will be sent.

Day 2

Child absent from school, no reason for absence provided
School office to call parents/carers
If school is unable to contact parents/carers a class DOJO message will be sent.
If no response an email will be sent to parents/carers
A home visit will be carried out by a member of staff

Return from unauthorised absence

Upon return to school from an unauthorised absence the school office will send home a notification for absence form requesting a reason for absence. If school does not receive a response within 2 days a member if staff will try to contact parents/carers to discuss the child's absence.

Continued Absence

All children's attendance will be monitored regularly, if your child's attendance falls below 95% you will begin to receive letters regarding this.

If your child's record shows 6 sessions of unauthorised absence you will be invited into school to meet with a member of staff to discuss any concerns.

If your child reaches 10 unauthorised sessions or school have further concerns regarding their attendance you will be invited to attend an Attendance Management Meeting where targets will be set. Following this meeting attendance will be closely monitored and reviewed. If your child's attendance does not improve a referral will be made to the Attendance Improvement Team which could lead to legal proceedings.

Dinner Money Increase Reminder
