Important reminders

Remember to have your book bags containing your personal organiser and reading book in school every day. We expect children to read at home and for an adult to comment/sign the personal organiser at least 3 times per week. For any child who struggles to keep up with reading at home, they can make use of playtimes or teatime club to do this.

Children should bring a **labelled** water bottle each day but toys or other personal belongings are not required.

Y4 Multiplication Tables Check

Times Tables Rockstars and other strategies will be used in school and encouraged to be used at home where possible to help prepare children for the online multiplication tables check for Y4 pupils which will be carried out in the summer term. TTRS login details will be sent out again for this.

The national curriculum specifies that pupils should be taught to recall the multiplication tables up to and including 12×12 by the end of year 4 so please support the children with this.

School uniform

PE

Our PE lessons take place on Wednesdays and Thursdays (swimming). PE kits should be left in school Monday-Friday to ensure your child has their kit for every session (red T-shirt and black or navy blue shorts/jogging trousers). Spelling/times tables

Across the year, children will continue to learn about spelling rules and different times tables and will get regular homework to help them develop their knowledge in these areas. If you wish to extend their learning at home, children can practise spellings from the spelling lists in their personal organisers and continue to develop fluency with all the multiplication tables up to and including 12×12 .
