Important reminders

Remember to have your book bags containing your reading record and reading book in school every day. We expect children to read at home and for an adult to comment/sign the reading record **at least 3 times per week**. Dojo points will be given for children who have more than 3 comments in their reading record. Children should also try to access **Reading Plus** at home as another way of developing fluency and comprehension skills. For any child who struggles to keep up with reading at home, they can make use of library sessions at lunchtime or homework club to do this.

Children should bring a **labelled** water bottle each day but toys or other personal belongings are not required.

We are continuing to use Class Dojo to reward children, share photos and give updates on class activities.

Y4 Multiplication Tables Check

Daily morning starters, Times Tables Rockstars and other strategies will continue to be used in school and encouraged to be used at home where possible to help prepare children for the online multiplication tables check for Y4 pupils which will be carried out in the summer term.

Jan/Feb: 3 Soundcheck games and 18 minutes playing Garage games per week.


March: 5 Soundcheck games and 16 minutes playing Garage games per week.

School uniform
